Financial Management of Not-for-Profit Organizations

For many nonprofit organizations, planning and financial management are activities that divide rather than unite the organization. Program planning is often viewed as the domain of the executive director, program directors and the board. Fiscal management is assigned to the bookkeeper, accounting and finance director and perhaps the board treasurer.
